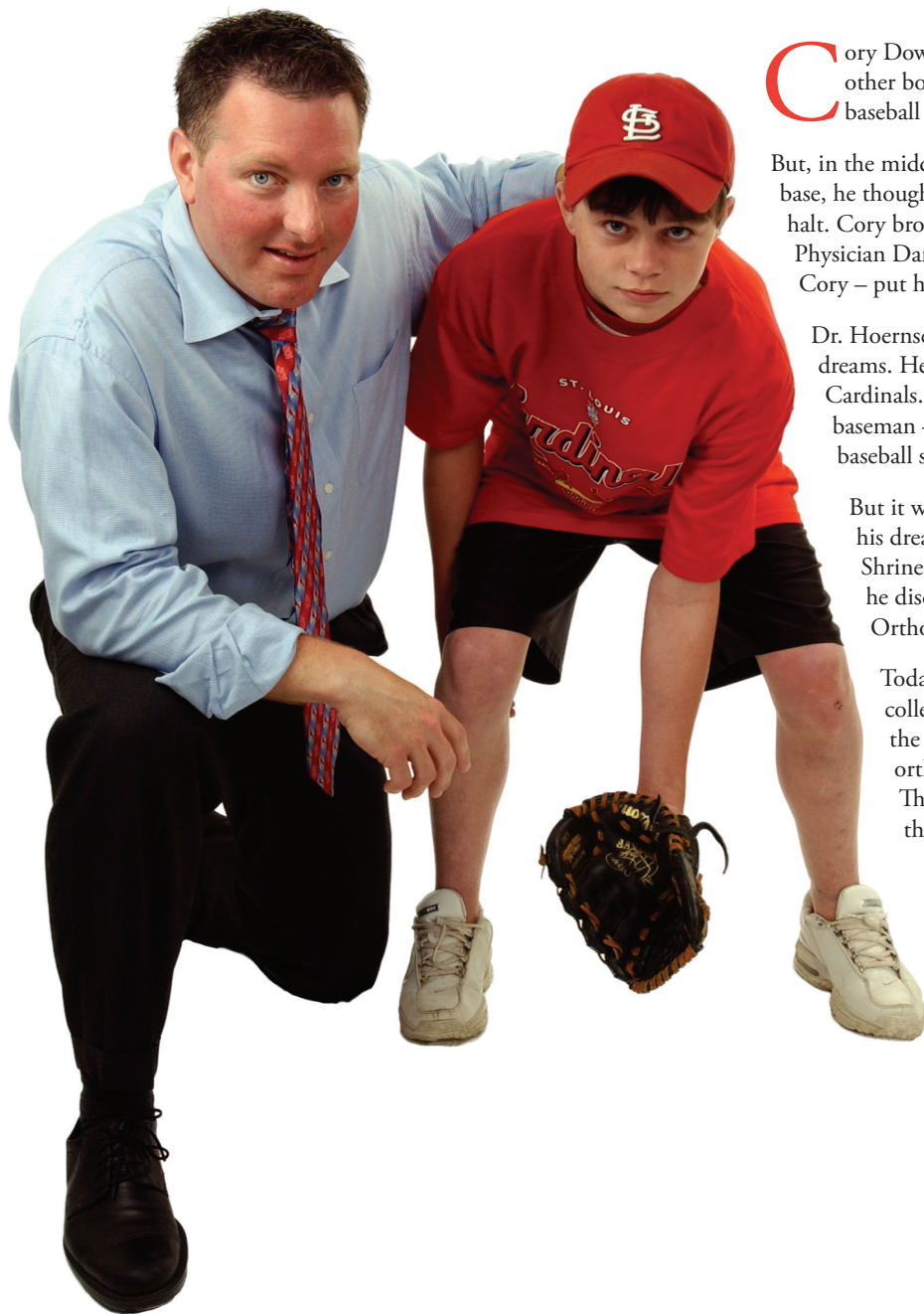


He resets broken dreams.
